The projects were carried out by international distributed student teams. Real-life problems to solve were submitted by Danish IT companies and startups. The development of projects was carried out applying Scrum Framework.

Many Scrum teams were created, which included a scrum master, developers, a product owner, and an agile coach. The work was organized remotely using the Trello, Zoom, Discord etc..

A wide range of frontend and backend technologies and tools were used: Java, C #, ASP.Net, Angular, React, JavaScript, NodeJS, GraphQL, Azure Server.







In addition to the professional skills, students gained unique experience of communicating with the product owner, teamwork experience, time management skills, public speaking skills, significantly improved english speaking skills.




The IntaActive project is a workplace analytics and corporate communications tool designed to track and display activity on company intranet pages.






